

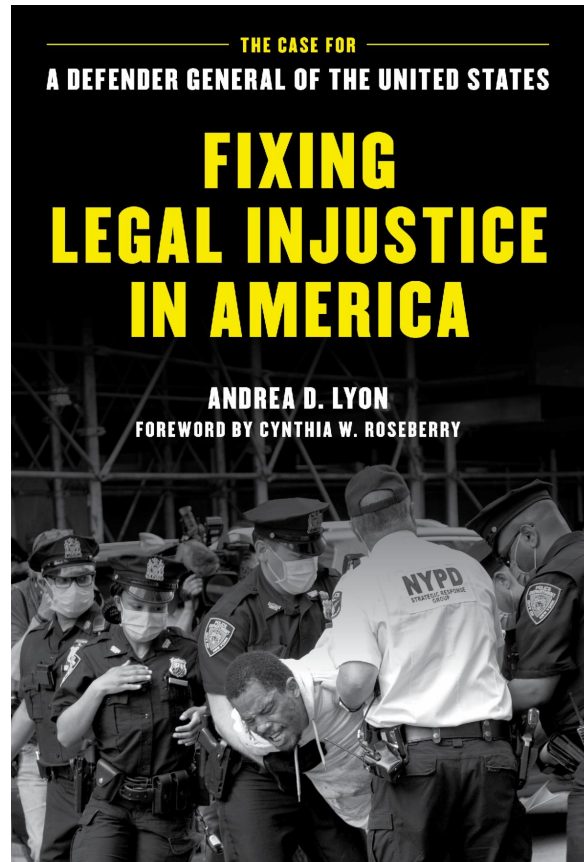
Read the **Executive Summary** of my new book, which will be published in 2022 answering the question: "What can we do to reform criminal justice?"
